Blessing and Dedication Ceremony in honor and memory of IWA alumni Sean Bush (1994-2019)




This past weekend, Incarnate




#### **COVID POLICY UPDATE**

# STEM SCHOLARSHIP FOR GIRLS Grades 7-12

In 2020, Lorraine Dodero of the Sam J. Frankino Foundation developed the Cleveland STEM Goes Red for Girls Scholarship with the goal of bridging the gap between student interests in pursuing a career in a STEM field (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) and achieving their goals. The 2021 Lorraine Dodero STEM Goes Red for Girls Scholarship will award five (5) scholarships of \$5,000 each to qualifying applicants.

Since IWA participated in the STEM Goes Red for Girls event, any of our female students in 7th-8th Grade are eligible to apply! The winners will be announced in the Spring of 2021, but can be applied for a future school year. Please note: these funds are held in a designated account for the student until the student enters college, so they should not be discouraged from applying if they are younger.

#### WINTER MAP TESTING



Beginning the week of January 11th, students in grades K-8 will begin taking the NWEA Map tests. These computer-adaptive tests are taken three times a year; in the fall, winter, and spring. Teachers use the results to inform instruction, personalize learning, and monitor the growth of individual students.

- Students in grades K-2 will take a Reading and Math test.
- Students in grades 3-8 will complete a Reading, Math, Science, and ELA test.

Most students will complete each test in about 30-45 minutes. Testing will continue the following week, with additional time for make-up tests as needed. We recommend that your child gets a full night of rest and a healthy breakfast during this testing window.
