<u>Directions:</u> Each student will need one brown paper bag to complete this project. The size of your bag depends on the size of the items that will be placed inside. You may use a brown lunch bag or a brown grocery store bag. Please include the following on the bag:

## Front of the Bag:

- Include the title of your book, the author, and a neatly colored illustration that represents the story.
- Include your first and last name.
- The front of your bag should be completely covered and drawn/colored by hand; no computer help!
- Full points will be given to bags which are especially colorful, detailed, and neatly completed.

## Back of the Bag:

- The back of your bag should contain a summary of your book.
- Your summary should be at least 7 sentences long.
- Be sure to include the key points from your book (beginning, middle, and end)!
- Make sure your summary is in your own words and written in complete sentences.
- Under your summary, write your favorite quote from the book. Remember to put your quote in quotation marks.

## Inside the Bag:

- Inside your bag, you should include 5 different items that represent the theme and story elements (characters, settings, problem, and solution) of your book.
- You may only include two drawings/pictures as part of the 5 items.

Upon the due date, you should be prepared to present your book project to your class.
